# **Purpose**

Pembroke Minor Hockey is proud to announce that **namebars will be permitted** on jerseys for the **2025–2026 season**. This policy outlines the rules, expectations, and requirements to ensure consistency, quality, and accountability.

# **Policy Guidelines**

## 1. Eligibility

 Namebars are optional but permitted on home and away jerseys for all divisions.

## 2. Ordering & Application

- All namebars must be ordered exclusively through Play It Again Sports (Pembroke location).
- All namebars must be professionally sewn on no velcro or iron-on applications are permitted.
- This policy also applies to any player receiving an "A" (Assistant Captain) or
  "C" (Captain) designation those letters must also be sewn on only.
- Play It Again Sports is aware of the required specifications for namebars and lettering.

#### 3. Name Format

- Only last names are allowed.
- No nicknames, first names, or inappropriate substitutions.
- Names must match the registered player's legal last name.

#### 4. Placement

- o Namebars are to be **sewn on the upper back** of the jersey, above the numbers.
- "A" and "C" letters must be sewn on the front chest area in the designated position.

### 5. Responsibility for Cost and Damage

- All costs related to ordering and sewing namebars or letters are the responsibility of the player, parent, or guardian.
- Any damage caused to jerseys due to improper application or removal of namebars or letters will also be the responsibility of the player, parent, or guardian.
- This includes potential repair or full replacement costs.

## 6. Jersey Return Requirements

- All namebars and letters must be completely removed from jerseys prior to returning them to PMHA.
- Jerseys returned with namebars or adhesive residue may be considered damaged.

## Reminders

- Namebars are **optional** but must follow these rules if applied.
- Improper or unapproved namebars or letters will be required to be removed.
- PMHA reserves the right to inspect jerseys and enforce repair or replacement fees as needed.
