UOVMHL Playoff Structure - 2024

House League, U11 - U18

Teams will be divided into divisions based on regular season standings. All levels will play off in a round robin series until March Break, after which teams will be seeded into head-to-head championship series.

February 5th to March 8th - Round Robin

• Number of games based on number of teams in division.

Six Teams – Five Games (play each opponent once)
 Seven Teams – Six Games (play each opponent once)

March 8th or 18th: Elimination Game (if required)

- For divisions with and odd number of teams (five or seven), the bottom two teams from the playoff standings will play a single game.
- Team that placed higher in playoff standings has home ice unless they are unable to provide ice on either of those dates and the lower placing team can do so.
- Winner of the elimination game moves on to the Division Championship series.

March 18th to 29th: Division Championship

- First to four points head-to-head series (details below)
- Gold 1st vs 2nd in each division
- Silver 3rd vs 4th in each division
- Bronze 5th vs 6th or winner of Elimination Game (if seven teams in division)

House League Divisions

U11 House - 21 Teams

A Division (7 Teams) – 1st through 7th B Division (7 Teams) – 8th through 14th C Division (7 Teams) – 15th through 21st

U15 House – 12 Teams

A Division (6 Teams) – 1st through 6th B Division (6 Teams) – 7th through 12th

U13 House - 13 Teams

A Division (6 Teams) – 1st through 6th B Division (7 Teams) – 7th through 13th

U18 House – 14 Teams

A Division (7 Teams) – 1st through 7th B Division (7 Teams) – 8th through 14th

Competitive League, U11 – U18

All levels will play off in a round robin series until March Break, after which teams will be seeded into head-to-head championship series.

February 5th to March 8th – Round Robin

Number of games based on number of teams in division.

Five Teams – Eight Games (play each opponent twice)
 Six Teams – Five Games (play each opponent once)

March 8th or 18th: Elimination Game (U18 Only)

- 4th and 5th place teams play a single elimination game.
- Team that placed higher in playoff standings has home ice unless they are unable to provide ice
 on either of those dates and the lower placing team can do so.
- Winner of the elimination game moves on to the Division Championship series.

March 18th to 29th: Division Championship

- First to four points head-to-head series (details below)
- A Division 1st vs 2nd
- B Division 3rd vs 4th or winner of Elimination Game (U18 Only)
- C Division 5th vs 6th

Head-to-head series format, House and Competitive:

- o First to four points.
- Maximum four games.
- Games 1 and 3 are played at the home arena of the highest seeded team from regular season.
- Two points are awarded for a win, one point for a tie.
- If ahead of Game 3 the series is tied at two points each, the home team coach may elect to play overtime in the third game. This decision must be made prior to the start of the game and communicated with the visiting coach in advance.
- Overtime must be played in Game 4 if the score is tied at the end of regulation.
- Overtime will be sudden victory with a series of five minute stop time periods. The first five minutes will be four on four. The second and subsequent five minute periods shall be three on three.
